

DAAD Prize

The TH Aschaffenburg awards the DAAD Prize 2025 to an outstanding international student or doctoral candidate who has distinguished him/herself through special academic achievements and remarkable social or intercultural commitment. The prize is endowed with 1.000,00 € and is funded by the DAAD with funds from the Federal Foreign Office (AA).

Who can apply?

Foreign students who are enrolled at the TH Aschaffenburg and primarily reside in Germany. Applicants should be at an advanced stage of their Bachelor's degree (at least 2nd or 3rd year of study) or Master's degree (at least 2nd semester), have a good academic record and be socially committed.

Documents required for the application:

- Application formular
- Current grade list
- Curriculum vitae
- Letter of motivation (max. 1 DIN A4 page)

Selection criteria:

- Professional qualification and previous academic performance (grade point average 2.5 or better)
- Ratio of ECTS credits achieved compared to the ECTS credits provided for in the curriculum
- Extracurricular qualifications and general personality traits of the applicant (in particular social or intercultural commitment)

Application deadline: 01 August 2025
